This 100 page booklet contains the names of about 1,834 Barbadians (780 female and 1,054 male) identified as freedmen in documentary sources. These were free coloured or blacks who were either born free or manumitted from slavery prior to general emancipation in 1834. The names were collected from a variety of sources, including wills, deeds, estate inventories, and newspaper articles as well as petitions and addresses submitted

to legislative bodies by freedmen during their struggle for civil rights. The names are arranged alphabetically by surname, followed by first name, and when known, an individual's racial category (e.g. "coloured" or "black") as described in the original source, is also included. A note is appended to each name indicating the primary source or sources, and year. Biographical information is also included when available.
